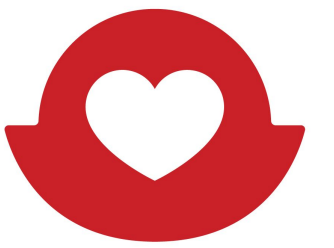

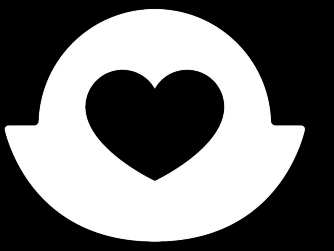
1. By supplying much needed PPE (Personal Protective Equipment) to medical professionals and staff.

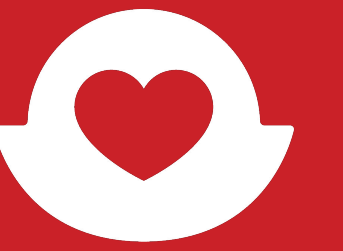

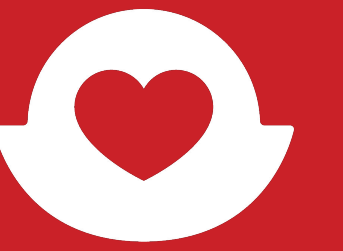


IMPORTANT ANNOUNCEMENT

As a result of the effort, control and monitoring of the Ministry of Health, **Zonkeys Auxiliary Hospital concludes its operation** due to the decrease in cases/patients that have been received in recent weeks.

However, the Let's Help Tijuana initiative and the Tijuana Zonkeys executive team have agreed that the facilities will continue as they are right now with O2 lines, compressed air, beds, air filtration systems and other important adjustments that will remain intact in case of being required again.

Let's Help Tijuana will continue with the collection and delivery of protective equipment and other items for public hospitals and civil organizations. This is because the Zonkeys Auxiliary Hospital only represents one wing of the double effort of Let's Help Tijuana, which will continue to supply medical equipment, food and hygiene products to the community.
